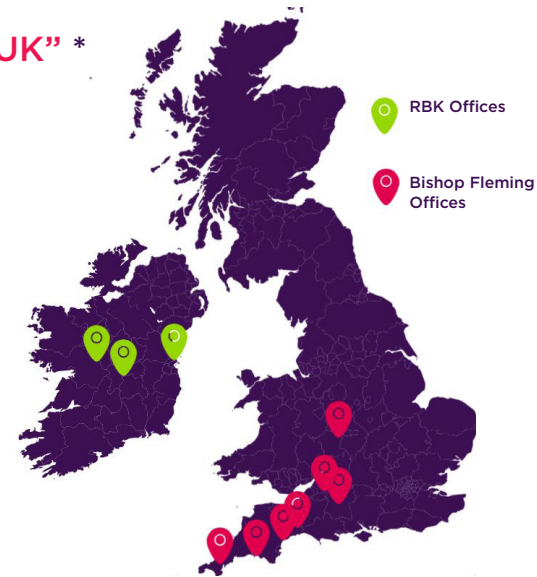


“84% of Irish companies are currently exporting to the UK” *
